

## Steel & Scrap 13-07-20

## Good morning,

US based seller transacts physical scrap at \$255.5/t CFR

Turkish scrap import prices continue to be rangebound, with a US-origin physical deal transacted late last week at \$255.5/t CFR levels for HMS 80:20. Scrap futures remained largely unchanged on Friday with the curve holding flat. The Northwest European HRC index ticked up 75 cents to €397/t, no trades were reported on block basis on Friday.

Chinese equities were up this morning amid positive signs of a return of Chinese economic growth in the second quarter. FOB China HRC futures reacted positively this morning with value ticking up a touch across the curve.
