Additional physical scrap from last week was reported yesterday. A Baltic based seller transacted HMS 80:20 at \$285/t CFR, the cargo also included shredded and bonus scrap at \$290/t and 295/t CFR. Furthermore, a US-origin deal was reported completed at \$285/t CFR for HMS 80:20. The scrap futures curve held steady yesterday with Oct futures trading \$283.50/t. Northwest European HRC moved €1.50/t higher yesterday. Argus reports one mill in the north upped its offer levels by €20/t to €460/t exw yesterday for the fourth quarter.

FOB China HRC held relatively steady yesterday; Argus reports Chinese mills kept offers levels unchanged at \$500-\$505/t fob for SS400 HRC material. There was no index print with Singapore holiday yesterday.
