UREA

The NOLA UREA market slide back a little bit to end the day in NOLA. In the morning session physical barges traded for September at \$230, and in the afternoon, we saw November barges trade twice at \$230. This created a bit of bearish sentiment in the market and we ended up seeing December futures trade \$228 to end the day.

NOLA DAP futures continue to see traction in the SEPT contract trading \$358 then \$359 today, with the first week of the SEPT index coming out tomorrow. Most speculate the first week print will be \$362.50 with the high being \$365. October was also discussed but failed to generate traction in the end.
