# Fertilizer Financial Markets Commentary/Curves

### **NOLA FUTURES & SWAPS**

## UREA

NOLA UREA futures were mostly unchanged in the nearby with slightly more bid support in the deferred. Specifically, \$235 traded for Feburary 2021 futures. In the nearby values traded lower on physical with \$216.50 trading for November barges, but \$216 was bid there on the follow. Hard to really tell where the market is going, most likely traders waiting for the dust to settle after this most recent Indian tender.

### UAN

UAN futures were mostly unchanged on little activity, but bid support remains the same.

### DAP

NOLA DAP futures continue to be active with November trading at \$246 in line with where value is for December. Values on physical are holding.

## INTERNATIONAL FUTURES

Intl paper was firmer in the nearby, following significant volume accepted against counterbids in RCF's tender. Buyers closed in on levels offered yesterday on the November contract for AG paper, but didn't quite trade. Buying interest also returned to Egypt urea paper, whilst Brazil was relatively flat. The bullish sentiment appeared constrained to the nearby, with less certainty for price direction much beyond November.
