

# Fertilizer Financial Markets Commentary/Curves

## NOLA FUTURES & SWAPS

UREA

NOLA UREA futures values are mostly unchanged to slightly softer on little activity in the nearby. However, in the deferred futures continue to trade for the March timeframe trading \$233 for March a total of 4.5kt today. Physical today was slow being framed up \$214//\$216 for October barges most of the day.

### UAN

NOLA UAN futures were flat for most of the day. Little changing there.

### DAP

NOLA DAP futures were a touch softer for December through Q1. After \$343 traded for December and Janurary futures, offers were there on the follow with bids slipping into the upper \$330s.

#### **INTERNATIONAL FUTURES**

Today saw further delays out of India, with RCF requesting another 2 day extension before issuing LOIs for their tender. The additional delay has now cast some doubt over whether 2.2mn tonnes will be booked as expected, with potential some participants may opt out of the business. On paper, AG traded a touch lower at \$251 for the December contract, down \$2 on last done levels. Bids on November meanwhile, crept back up to \$257, but sellers remain north of \$260.
