NOLA FUTURES & SWAPS

UREA

NOLA urea futures were soft today, with Q2 contracts trading as low as \$240 in the late afternoon. The nearby futures held up a bit better, though the overall tone was decidedly negative. Sellers seemed to get more agressive as the day wore on.

UAN activity was quiet today. JAN futures traded at \$130 which was lower than last done, but overall interest was low.

DAP

DAP was steady to slightly firm today, with JAN and FEB contracts both trading in the low \$380s. Buying interst was particularly firm in the afternoon, with JAN reaching as high as \$383.

INTERNATIONAL FUTURES

The front end of the curve across intl urea futures remains firm, however Q1 is less certain with buyers seemingly more retreated throughout the week. Conviction to enter new positions is lacklustre as the market looks to the next catalyst for a price move.
