Fertilizer Financial Markets Commentary/Curves

NOLA FUTURES & SWAPS

UREA

NOLA urea physical values pushed past \$340 today, and futures prices touched \$350 during today's session. Values on NOLA UREA futures received fresh bullish sentiment on more talk of an Indian tender. March was in focus again with barges trading in the low \$340s, and trading as high as \$344. In the futures market, \$350 was the high of the day, and \$346 traded multiple times. February traded as high as \$349 and April bids got as high as \$348. May was also firmer, with futures framed up at one point near \$328//\$338. Overall sentiment continues to remain firm heading into the spring season with few seeing bearish catalysts.

<u>UAN</u>

NOLA UAN futures continue to firm up with values in Cincinnati moving up as well, now posted at \$227 at the terminal. NOLA futures traded as high as \$226 on MAR and \$229 on APR. Values remain supported throughout the day and into the afternoon on futures.

DAP

NOLA DAP futures were firmer today based on firmer sentiment in the physical market. Physical MAP barges traded for NOLA delivery at \$550, up over \$100 since the beginning of the year. The values on MAP seem to be pulling DAP higher, with \$502 trading for a phys barges on LH FEB. In the futures market, values continue to firm up with much activity trading in the \$490-\$502 range. Offers were noted around \$510 at the COB for MAR futures. The climb continues for Phosphate fertilizer after breaking \$500 today.

INTERNATIONAL FUTURES

Intl paper markets took a slight pause today after a relatively active start to the week. AG paper found support with further buying interest near 350 again today for the March contract, but sellers were a touch more shy. Sentiment remains bullish with rumours that an Indian tender could be announced as early as next week. On physical, Egyptian urea values made a modest price increase, with business reported \$2 higher than last done, at \$362, whilst cfr Brazil was rumoured to have traded at \$366/mt.
