<u>UREA</u>

Values on NOLA UREA was mostly unchanged today in the futures market with little business being done. Players in the physical market are still waiting for the interior market to start kicking off and subsequently there is little activity in the NOLA UREA market. In the futures market, we are seeing the same narrative where it's quiet in futures until the physical market starts showing some signs of direction. Some players recognize the INTL market seems like it's looking bearish, but those some of those players say it doesn't matter as the U.S. will trade on an island during season.

INTERNATIONAL FUTURES

International paper markets remain soft. Brazil urea paper saw increased selling interest sub 400, sharpening further out the curve, against limited buying interest.
