

Fertilizer Derivatives End of Day Report

NOLA FUTURES & SWAPS

HREA

Lackluster end to the week on NOLA UREA. In the physical markets we saw a barge for October and November trade at \$690 and was bid there on the follow, this is up from last done on November barges trading \$685 yesterday. In the futures market, it seems like it's fairly bid supported with little offer interest. At the time this was written nothing had traded in the futures market.

UAN

NOLA UAN futures showed impressive strength today after CF issued new offers late yesterday afternoon. CF offered UAN for the first time since September yesterday at \$535 for Q4 and Q1. This was noticeably higher than Nutiren's last offer at \$500 and sharply above CF's own last offer for Q4 at \$425. While the higher offer was not unexpected, the actual prices were still viewed as supportive, and we heard that actual volumes filled were very limited. Mid-morning, January futures traded at \$555 and \$565. Last done for January futures was \$547 which traded yesterday afternoon. March simultaneously traded at \$565, and then again 10 minutes later at \$565. The Q1 futures strip traded at \$564 about 25 minutes later. In the later afternoon session traders were still bullish and subsquently, we saw \$573 trade for Q2 and \$560 then \$568 trade for NOV and EC contracts respectively.

DAP

Phosphate markets were extremely quiet in NOLA today with no observed physical trades and only one cleared futures trade. The December DAP futures contract traded early this morning at \$672. Offers were seen on the follow, but buyers were essentially nonexistent. There is talk of US farmer demand destruction at these price levels, but participants are still concerned about the lack of China exports available to the rest of the world.

INTERNATIONAL FUTURES

Egypt urea futures under selling pressure again today, with buyers not engaging. There was little activity elsewhere in a quiet end to a quiet week.
