Trades Recap:

A quiet day on the clean Tanker FFAs.

TC2 & TC6 Dec were both trading down, TC2 Dec to 156 and TC6 Dec down to 184.

TC6 Dec/Jan spread was trading flat at 12.0435\$/mt.

TC5 Dec was trading slightly higher at 124.

Nothing trading today on TC12, TC14 & TC17.

TD3C Jan traded 8.25\$/mt then fell to 8.05\$/mt and the Jan/Feb -0.2c (8/8.20). Q1 traded the same level as yesterday, 8.30 \$/mt and Q2 slipped from 8.50\$/mt through 8.40\$/mt to 8.35\$/mt. Calendars traded in strong volumes today. Cal22 slipped under 9\$/mt, opening at 9.05\$/mt, 9\$/mt and then slipped to 8.90\$/mt. Cal23 was crossed at 10.40\$/mt then 10.30\$/mt, Cal24 at 10.90\$/mt and the Cal25 at 11.90\$/mt. Cal22+23+24 package traded 9.05/10.45/11.40\$/mt and the strip at 10.10 \$/mt.
