The market is just quiet and profit takers were keen to take profits today. Physical markets are quiet after \$900 traded yesterday for physical barges.

## **INTL UREA FUTURES**

International futures markets continued their lower trend todaym, though actual activity was very quiet. Sell pressure was still sharp, and buyer interest was retracted. Many participants feel the market is moving lower due to reports of progressing peace talks between Ukraine and Russia, and others are worried that Russia could play a major part of the upcoming Indian tender. Whichever explanation you look at, there is clearly a lot of uncertainty in the market related to geopolitcal tensions, which is notoritously difficult to trade on.
