Fertilizer Derivatives End of Day Report

FUTURES MARKET COMMENTARY

Mixed day in the trade. The international futures seemed firmer with Q3 EGYPT trading up to \$750 up from trading \$720 earlier in the week, but in NOLA values were down \$15-\$25 on the day trading \$718 for Q3 NOLA UREA futures down from where we saw value at yesterday at COB (~\$630). Although sales were getting done around \$720 for EGYPT physical, rumors started to swirl at the beginning of the morning session in the US stating that India might only take 1M tonnes after they received confirmation for 1.65M tonnes. Almost immediately NOLA reacted with \$615 trading for May barges (down \$20), and Q3 NOLA UREA futures trading down to \$618. The rest of the day was quiet, that was it, quick drop in the morning session then very little interest later in the day. We are still awaiting India to issue LOI's to see what the final number will be that gets done in this latest RCF tender.
