FUTURES MARKET COMMENTARY

NOLA: A bit of yo-yo action today in NOLA. In the morning session we saw phys and futures trade lower with phys trading \$620 for SEPT/OCT phys and Q4 futures trading \$640/\$630/\$626. However, later in the day we saw everything trade higher with Q1 trading back up to \$680 and Q4 months indicated in the \$650s for futures. In the physical market we saw OCT phys trade \$630 trade for FH OCT barges at the end of the day. The market continues to be choppy here.

INTL: We continued to see heavier sell interest across all urea contracts today in the INTL futures market. Early in the morning Q4 EGYPT traded at \$815 OTC, but then as the day went on sellers got more aggressive - offering down to \$800 on Q4 but then eventually getting down to \$780 offer. AG futures were also weaker trading \$667.50 for Q4 AG futures down from the last done trade last week of \$745. Brazil was also weaker today trading \$690/\$685 (in that order) for OCT Brazil Urea swaps.
