There are a lot of issues going on along the river which has perhaps kept buyers a bit on their heels in the nearby, plus the upper is closed now. Anyway, we did see prices slack off a bit today with \$635 trading for Q1 on UFV and all the way out in JUN 2023, \$575 trading.

INTL: Even though the IPL counters were expected today they didn't come with most expecting they come tomorrow. The market didn't really take too well to this, dropping on EGYPT futures to \$700 for DEC, down \$50 from the highs last week on DEC22 contract. It seems like we'll find more clarity after this most recent tender gets done.
