Market has gone quiet in the NOLA UREA futures today. After seeing MAY EGYPT futures trade for 15kt in the early morning session it seemed that maybe NOLA would catch some more interest today after seeing a tick up in activity yesterday. However, trades were limited today and we didn't see any cleared trades at the time this report was written. Overall, quiet day – values are sideways.

<u>INTL</u>

International futures consideration was really limited to one market today, Egypt. The EGYPT futures market traded three times for the MAY contract down to \$310 which is \$20 from where we had it marked at COB yday. This is lower than where last cleared trades happened (February 14th). News from the publications suggest offers into Europe are dropping which may be one of the reasons we're seeing the EGYPT contract come under pressure.
