

STEEL SCRAP FREIGHT REPORT

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Hot News

- **Semis Displace Scrap Demand:** Turkey saw 155,000 tonnes of billet and slab arrivals last week, significantly reducing local demand for scrap and dragging CFR prices down to \$345.50–346/t.
- **Scrap Prices Rebound as Semis Ease:** With fewer semis arriving this week, US exporters were able to push scrap offers back up to \$348/t.
- **Freight Rates Respond:** The firmer scrap pricing translated into higher freight levels, reflecting the improved margin for US-origin cargoes into Turkey

Market Commentary

Steel Scrap

Turkish deepsea scrap remains locked at \$347/mt CFR, but the range has tightened to \$346–348/mt from last week's broader \$345–350. A benchmark Iskenderun booking fixed the market, yet trading stayed thin as both sides held back. Mills face September cover requirements, with attention now firmly on the Sept. 11 central bank decision and regional geopolitics that could shape steel demand.

Handysize & Supramax

Ultramax rates pushed up another \$663 to \$17,550, outpacing Handsize gains of \$432 to \$12,849. The spread widened \$231 to \$4470, reflecting stronger demand for larger parcels, while Handysize gains remain cargo-specific. HS4 (US Gulf via USG/NCSA to Skaw–Passero) jumped \$1,536 to \$16,750/day on firm transatlantic demand and tighter tonnage. In the Ultramax size, S4A (US Gulf–Skaw/Passero) increased a more modest \$475 to \$28,350, driven by moderate eastbound grain demand and restricted US Gulf supply, though these pressures seems to be losing steam.






