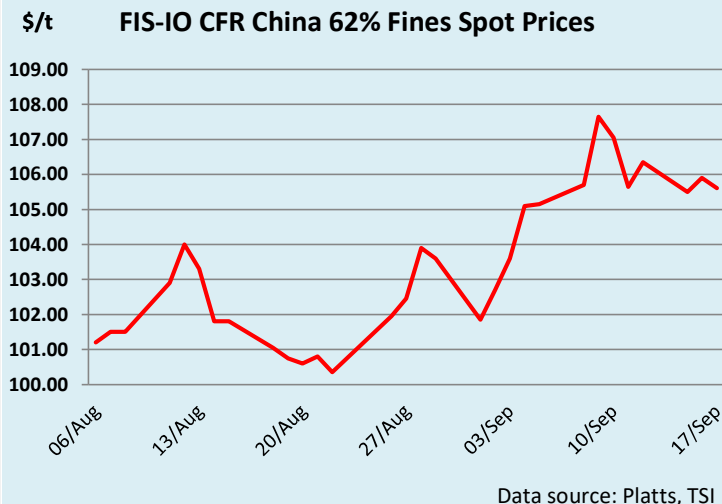

Market Commentary / Recent Trades

The Singapore morning session opened at \$105.80, with flat price falling to a low of \$105.30 before climbing to a high of \$106.30 and closing at \$106.20. Little activity was seen in this session across both outright and spreads, with most of the trading in prompt months in small clips.

The afternoon session was similarly quiet, with activity again focused on prompt months trading in smalls. Spreads continued to tighten throughout the day, as seen in Oct/Nov trading at par in multiple 20kt clips, with the largest size trade of the day being 90kt. Further down the curve, Q4/Q1 also saw liquidity, trading at \$3.15 in multiple clips totaling 60kt.

DCE iron ore futures remained stable, with the most-traded Jan26 contract closing slightly lower at ¥804.5/mt. Market activity was moderate, with traders showing average enthusiasm and steel mills purchasing as needed. Although hot metal production rose slightly, it fell short of expectations due to increased blast furnace maintenance amid shrinking steel mill profits. Despite this, iron ore demand remains resilient, supporting spot prices. Market sentiment is also buoyed by expectations of U.S. interest rate cuts and supportive Chinese monetary policy, suggesting prices may stay elevated in the short term.

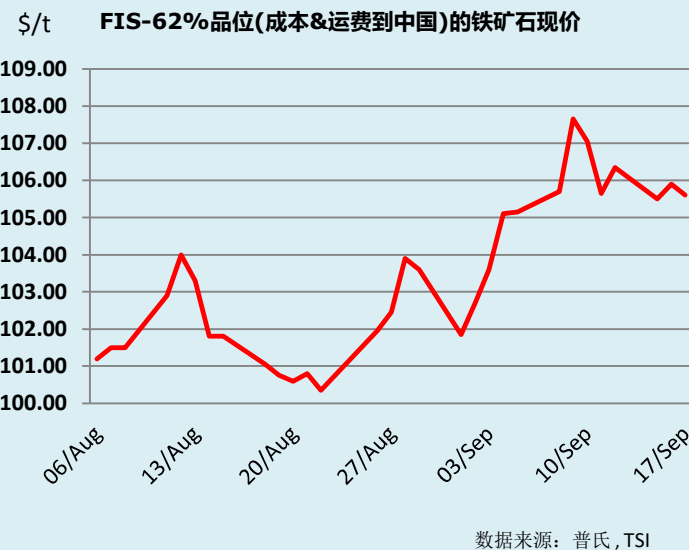

市场评论 / 近期交易

新加坡今早开盘于105.80美元，10月跌至105.30美元的低点，随后反弹至106.30美元的高点，最终收于106.20美元。盘中单月合约和价差合约交易均相对清淡，交易量较少，即期合约以小额交易为主。

午盘市场依然安静，即期合约是主力合约。价差继续收窄，其中10月/11月价格持平时多次交易2万吨，最大一笔交易9万吨。远期合约方面，Q4/Q1也有一些交易量，在3.15美元总计交易6万吨。

大连铁矿石期货保持稳定，主力合约26年1月小幅下跌至804.5元/吨。市场交易相对温和，投资者积极性一般，钢厂按需采购。尽管热金属产量小幅回升，但由于高炉检修增加、钢厂利润收缩，产量未达预期。铁矿需求依然强劲，实货价格获得支撑。市场情绪也受到美国预期降息与中国宽松货币政策的支撑，短期价格或稳定于高点。
