Market Commentary / Recent Trades

The Singapore morning session opened at \$105.70, climbed to a high of \$105.80, then dipped to lows of \$103.95 before closing at \$104.55. Little activity was seen in the morning session. Feb outright remained active, trading in the range of \$104.20–\$105.20 in 517kt, while Feb/Mar was seen trading at -\$0.05 in 75kt. The Mar/Jun spread was seen trading at \$0.40 in 100kt, signalling keen selling, before trading again at \$0.50 in a further 100kt. Quarter spreads remained of interest since last week, with Q1-26/Q3-26 trading in 29.5kt and Q1-26/Q2-26 trading at \$0.60 in 20kt. Spreads generally remained unchanged.

When the afternoon session resumed, trading remained muted. The Jan/Mar spread remained of interest late in the month, trading at \$1.35 in 150kt. Feb/Apr continued to be seen since last week, trading at par in 130kt. After DCE closed, quarter spreads and outright continued to trade, with Q2-26/Q3-26 trading at \$0.95 in 30kt and Q1-26 trading in the range of \$105.00–\$105.50 in 50kt. Mar/Jun remained active from the morning, trading at \$0.50 in 300kt.

According to China Baowu Steel Group, the first shipment of nearly 200,000 tonnes of Simandou iron ore arrived at a Chinese port on January 17, while a second shipment had already been dispatched at the end of last year. Mysteel data showed a mild w/w easing in steelmaking activity, with the blast furnace operating rate at 78.84% across 247 mills, down 0.47% w/w and up 1.66% y/y, while utilization stood at 85.48%, down 0.56% w/w and up 1.20% y/y. Average daily hot metal output was 2.28 million tonnes, down 14,900 tonnes w/w but up 51,300 tonnes y/y.

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市场评论 / 近期交易

新加坡今早开盘于105.70美元，上涨至105.80美元的高点后回落，跌至103.95美元的低点，最终收于104.55美元。早盘整体交易清淡。2月合约保持活跃，在104.20至105.20美元交易51.7万吨，2月/3月价差在负0.05美元交易7.5万吨。3月/6月价差在0.40美元交易10万吨，抛售积极，随后又在0.50美元再度交易10万吨。自上周以来，季度价差一直有不错的市场兴趣，26年Q1/26年Q3交易2.95万吨，26年Q1/26年Q2在0.60美元交易2万吨。整体价差变化不大。

午盘交易依旧偏淡。临近月底，1月/3月价差交易兴趣持续存在，在1.35美元交易15万吨。2月/4月自上周持续成交，价格持平交易13万吨。大商所收盘后，季度价差及单月合约继续交易，26年Q2/26年Q3在0.95美元交易3万吨，26年Q1在105.00至105.50美元之间交易5万吨。3月/6月延续早盘交易，在0.50美元交易30万吨。

据中国宝武钢铁集团消息，今年第一艘船接近20万吨的西芒杜铁矿石已于1月17日抵达中国港口，第二船已于去年年底出发。Mysteel数据显示，钢铁生产活动本周小幅回落，247家钢厂高炉开工率为78.84%，周下降0.47个百分点、但较去年上升1.66个百分点。高炉利用率为85.48%，周下降0.56个百分点、但较去年上升1.20个百分点。日均铁水产量为228万吨，周下降1.49万吨，但较去年增加5.13万吨。
