

## Hot News

- Rio Tinto pauses Simandou** – Uncertainty around high-grade iron ore supply adds cost pressure across the metallics chain.
- Coronado cuts US met coal output** – Production curtailments tighten the coal floor, limiting raw material downside.
- Turkey pig iron imports surge 64% in 2025** – Heavier Russian inflows reshape metallics demand and reduce scrap price sensitivity.

## Market Commentary

## Steel Scrap

- Turkish deepsea scrap eased to \$375.00/mt CFR (w/w -\$1.00), with US-origin deals concluded at \$375.00/mt CFR and tradable levels at \$375.00/mt for US/premium origin and \$368.00/mt CFR for EU material, leaving the market firmly rangebound.
- Supply remained supported, with US winter weather tightening collection, New Jersey–Turkey freight rising and firm US domestic pricing underpinning export offers despite thin deal flow.
- Demand stayed subdued, with export rebar at \$553.00/mt FOB and the scrap–rebar spread near \$178.00/mt, keeping margins compressed and mills resistant to higher scrap.

## Physical / FFA

- UMX / SMX: The Atlantic continued to pay despite a slight easing end of week, while the Pacific gained traction on coal support from PMX. S4A\_63 slipped just \$14 w/w to \$30,054/day, but the broader S11TC rose \$505 to \$14,917/day, underscoring resilience despite softer US Gulf momentum.
- Handy: A clear step higher, led by firm Atlantic demand. HS4\_38 surged \$3,450 w/w to \$24,343/day, with HS7TC up \$816 to \$12,634/day, confirming accelerating strength in the smaller sizes.
- FFA: Prompt paper corrected modestly, easing around \$50 to \$12,650/day, while the forward strip firmed into grain season. Q2-26 rose to \$16,550/day and Q3-26 to \$15,150/day, up roughly \$350 450 w/w, signalling growing conviction in second-quarter momentum.

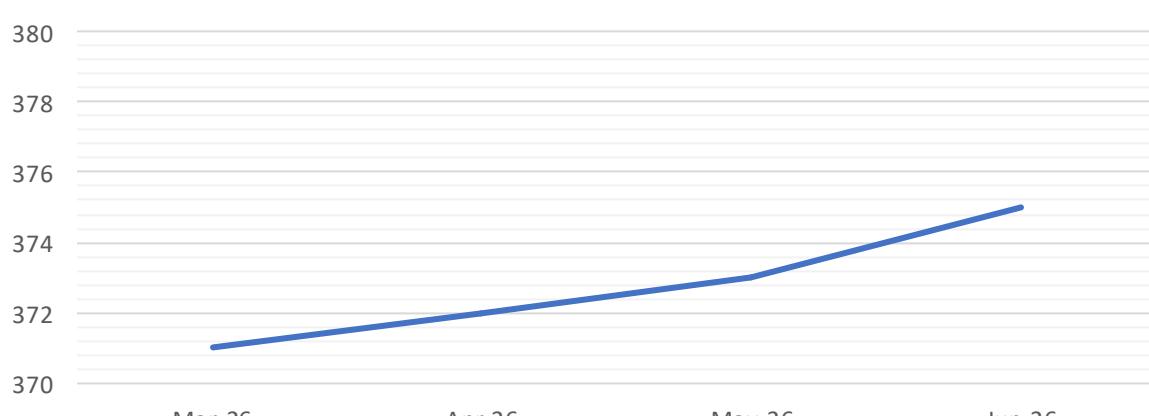

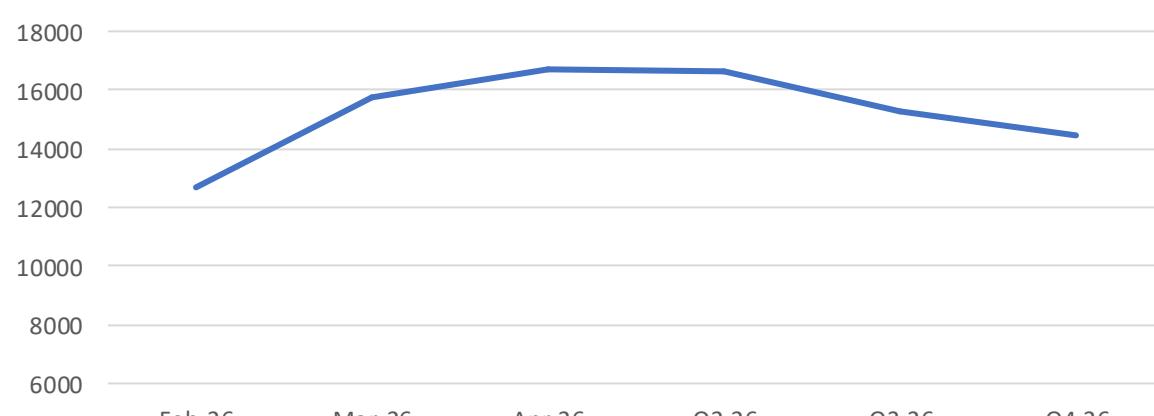

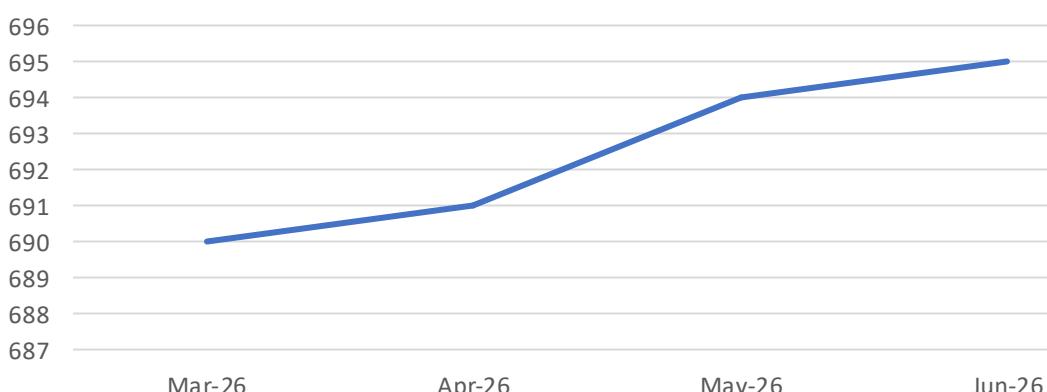
### LME HMS 80:20 CFR Turkey Indic Curve



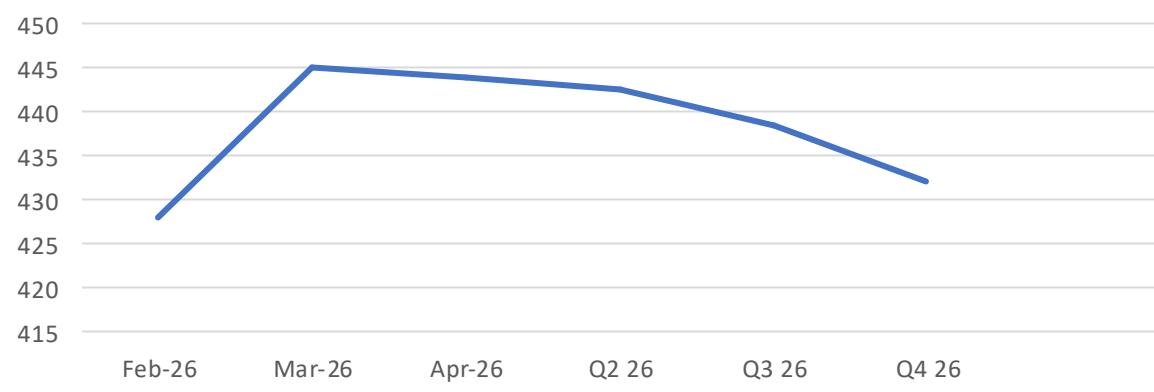
### Supramax 10TC Indic Curve
